- SUBJECT** : FIFTH SUPPLEMENT AND/OR AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER (EO) NO. 21-010, s. 2021, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDER ESTABLISHING MANDATORY PROTOCOLS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAVELERS GOING TO THE PROVINCE OF SURIGAO DEL NORTE IN ACCORDANCE WITH IATF RESOLUTION NO. 101 DATED FEBRUARY 26, 2021"

In view of the downgrading of quarantine classification of Metro Manila and the Provinces of Bulacan, Rizal, Laguna and Cavite from "Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ)" to "General Community Quarantine with Restrictions," the undersigned hereby order as follows:

- Lifting of Modified Limited No Travel Policy as regards NCR+.** The "Modified Limited No Travel Policy" of all persons coming from Metro Manila and the Provinces of Bulacan, Cavite, Laguna and Rizal is hereby LIFTED subject to mandatory travel protocols and requirements in mentioned in EO No. 21-010, s. 2021.
- Reiteration of Mandatory Travel Protocols and Requirements in Siargao Island Airport and Surigao City Airport.** All passengers of aircrafts (whether commercial, chartered or private flights) going to this Province through Siargao Island Airport and Surigao City Airport shall present the following upon boarding at the airport of origin and upon arrival to this Province, to wit:

a.) For Surigao del Norte residents

- Negative Result on RT-PCR Test or Negative Result on COVID-19 Saliva Test taken within forty eight (48) hours or two (2) days from the date of release of

For Government Authorized Persons Outside Residence (APOR) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Negative Result on RT-PCR Test or Negative Result on COVID-19 Saliva Test taken within forty eight (48) hours or two (2) days from the date of release of the result; Valid Identification Card; and Travel/Mission Order issued by the Chief of Office. |

For Nonresident Private APOR | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Negative Result on RT-PCR Test or Negative Result on COVID-19 Saliva Test taken within forty eight (48) hours or two (2) days from the date of release of the result; Valid Identification Card; and Confirmed Booking of Accommodation for at least two (2) nights from the resort, hotel or hostel duly accredited by the Department of Tourism. |
| d.) For Tourists invited by local resident of Surigao del Norte | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Negative Result on RT-PCR Test or Negative Result on COVID-19 Saliva Test taken within forty eight (48) hours or two (2) days from the date of release of the result; Valid Identification Card; and Travel Certification issued by the Mayor of the City/Municipality of destination (within the Province of Surigao del Norte), |

For Tourists not invited by local residents of Surigao del Norte (Walk-in tourists) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Negative Result on RT-PCR Test or Negative Result on COVID-19 Saliva Test taken within forty eight (48) hours or two (2) days from the date of release of the result; Valid Identification Card; and Confirmed Booking of Accommodation for at least two (2) nights from the resort, hotel or hostel duly accredited by the Department of Tourism. |

Negative Result on RT-PCR Test or COVID-19 Saliva Test taken within forty eight (48) hours or two (2) days from the date of release of the result is still required for those who have been partially or fully vaccinated of COVID-19 vaccines.

3. **Reiteration of Mandatory Travel Protocols and Requirements in Seaports and Other Points of Entry.** Travelers going to this Province by sea (through Eva Macapagal Passenger Terminal, Lipata Ferry Terminal as well as Ports of Dapa, Del Carmen, San Benito, Sta Monica, Socorro and

such other seaports within this Province) or by land (through the Municipalities of Alegria, Claver and Mainit, all of this Province) shall follow the following mandatory protocols and requirements:



| <p>c.) For Tourists invited by local resident of Surigao del Norte</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Negative Result on RT-PCR Test or Negative Result on COVID-19 Saliva Test taken within forty eight (48) hours or two (2) days from the date of release of the result; • Valid Identification Card; and • Travel Certification issued by the Mayor of the City/Municipality of destination (within the Province of Surigao del Norte). <p>If the travel is by sea, the aforementioned documentary requirements shall be presented upon boarding at the port of origin and upon arrival to this Province. On the other hand, if the travel is by land, the aforementioned documentary requirements shall be presented upon demand at any of the checkpoints within this Province.</p> |

Negative Result on RT-PCR Test or COVID-19 Saliva Test taken within forty eight (48) hours or two (2) days from the date of release of the result is still required for those who have been partially or fully vaccinated of COVID-19 vaccines.

All provisions of prior orders, rules and regulations, other issuances or part thereof which are inconsistent with the provision/s of this order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

This order shall take effect immediately.
