EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 21-014

“AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE PAYAPA AT MASAGANANG PAMAYANAN - PROJECT MANAGEMENT TEAM (PAMANA-PMT) OF THE PROVINCE OF SURIGAO DEL NORTE”

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and Office of the Presidential Adviser on Peace Process (OPAPP) issued a Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) in June 2016 on the “Guidelines in the Management of the PAYapa at MASaganang PamayaNAn or PAMANA-DILG Fund for Infrastructure Component”;

WHEREAS, PAMANA Program is a framework for intervention in Conflict Affected and Vulnerable areas to complement the government’s peace and negotiation efforts in line with its commitment to address the causes of conflict and issues affected the peace process;

WHEREAS, the program aims to reduce poverty and vulnerability in conflict affected areas; improve governance; and empower communities and strengthen their capacities to address issues conflict and peace through activities that promote social cohesion;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstitute the Project Management Team (PMT) to ensure smooth implementation of the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FRANCISCO T. MATUGAS, Provincial Governor of Surigao del Norte, do hereby order the following:

Sec. 1. Creation. – There is hereby created a PAMANA Project Management Team (PMT) as hereinafter provided.

Sec. 2. Composition. – The PMT shall be composed of the following:

- Provincial Planning and Development Office
- Provincial Engineering Office
- Provincial Agriculture Office
- Provincial Treasurer’s Office
- Provincial Accounting Office
- Provincial Budget Office
- Provincial General Services Office

The DILG and OPAPP shall provide coordinative and technical services.

Sec. 3. Powers, Duties and Functions. The PMT shall assume the following responsibilities:

- a) Coordinate provincial / municipal programs, activities and funding requirements for areas identified under PAMANA;
- b) Mainstream PAMANA interventions into plans and programs of concerned local government units;
- c) Facilitate planning, review and endorse program and project interventions;
- d) Coordinate with relevant agencies, development partners and CSOs, project management offices on the implementation of the PAMANA in the LGU;
- e) To conduct a regular monthly meeting or as the need arises; and
- f) Monitor implementation of PAMANA in the province/municipality.

Sec. 4. PAMANA Focal Person. - There shall be a designated PAMANA Focal Person under the Office of the Provincial Planning and Development which shall handle the administrative and technical activities of the PMT. The Secretariat shall also undertake liasoning and coordination of activities with appropriate agencies.

Sec. 5. Term. - The PMT shall exist until it has accomplished the purpose of this Order.

Sec. 6. Funding. - Subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations, the PMT shall be provided with a budget chargeable to the PAMANA Fund.

Sec. 7. Effectivity. - This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
